Dear Parent/Carers,

Following an extremely popular and successful residential trip to Kingswood last November we are now planning a similar trip for this year. A provisional booking has been made to take our Year 6 pupils (present Y5) on a residential Action Adventure to Kingswood Activity centre near Hexham from Wednesday, 7th November 2018 to Friday, 9th November 2018.

As I'm sure you know, residential courses organised by the school are an optional, but invaluable, part of the National Curriculum. Children benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially, and I feel certain that the course we have chosen for next year will prove to be both enjoyable and worthwhile.

The total cost of the course will be a voluntary contribution of £127. This includes travel between the school and Kingswood Centre, full board accommodation and a full programme of activities supervised by qualified instructors. A visit to the Baltic Centre for Contemporary Art in Gateshead, en-route to the centre is also included in the price.

There will be an information evening on Thursday 12th July at 6.00pm in the school hall regarding the visit to Kingswood. The meeting will give you details about the trip; what to expect, how the trip is run and other useful information.

To confirm our booking a deposit of £20 per child will be required by Thursday, 19th July 2018 with the balance to be paid by Monday, 24th September 2018.
