Bronze Award: Complete all the compulsory red tasks plus 1 other challenges.

Silver Award: Complete all the compulsory red tasks plus 2 other challenges.

Gold Award: Complete all the compulsory red tasks plus 3 other challenges.

The focus is QUALITY WORK, not just completing tasks quickly (you have 10 weeks!) Think carefully about the presentation and content of your work and make sure you give your BEST to produce work to be proud of.

You can complete this on the computer, by hand or a bit of both!
