Silver Award: Complete the compulsory red tasks plus 2 other challenges.

<p>Design a poster to show how you count in your 2s, 5s and 10s. Make your poster as colourful as possible. Make sure all of your numbers are the right way round.</p>	<p>Talk to someone much older than you, e.g. grandparents and ask them what their favourite toy was when they were your age. Research the toy and write 3 sentences about it.</p>	<p>Write a book review of your favourite book. What did you like about the book? What is the book called? Would you recommend the book to a friend? Why?</p>
<p>Draw a map of your bedroom. Think of labelling all the things that will always stay there and can't be moved in one colour e.g. the window, the door, the walls. Draw and label other things which can be moved in a different colour e.g. your bed, your drawers etc.</p>	<p>Write an acrostic poem to represent your name. What wonderful adjectives can you use to describe yourself? Perform your poem to your family.</p>	<p>Design your own Christmas biscuits. Write a list of what you will need to make them.
