Bronze Award: Complete all the compulsory red tasks plus 1 other challenges.

Silver Award: Complete all the compulsory red tasks plus 2 other challenges.

Gold Award: Complete all the compulsory red tasks plus 3 other challenges.

The focus is QUALITY WORK, not just completing tasks quickly (you have 10 weeks!) Think carefully about the presentation and content of your work and make sure you give your BEST to produce work to be proud of.

You can complete this on the computer, by hand or a bit of both!

You should pick 1 human (created by people eg the colosseum) and 1 physical feature (naturally occurring eg Mount Vesuvius)</p>
<p><u>English</u> Design a new sweet to be made in Willy Wonka's factory and create an advert for it. This could be a poster, a radio advert (sound recording) or a video advert.</p>	<p><u>Computer Science</u> Create a collage of photos of a subject of your choice. Edit the pictures by cropping, flipping or changing colours. or Can you find examples of images in the media that you think have been altered? Why do people edit pictures in this way?</p>	<p><u>French</u> Create a poster about different types of weather in French. or Film yourself presenting an imaginary weather forecast in French.</p>
<p><u>Art</u> Kandinsky used shape and colour to represent emotions. Create an abstract piece using any media that shows an emotion.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Use diagrams to explain how we hear sounds. What changes when the sounds we hear change?</p>	<p><u>PE</u> Set up a mini Olympics or sports day for your family at home. What athletic skills did you have to perform?</p>
